System requirements for Microsoft Exchange Server 2019:

1. Hardware Requirements:

- Processor: 64-bit processors from Intel or AMD.
- Memory: At least 128 GB RAM for installation.
- Disk Space:
 - 20 GB for installation.
 - 200 MB free space on the system drive.
 - 500 MB free space on the Message Queue Database drive.

2. Operating System:

- Windows Server 2022 (Standard or Datacenter).
- Windows Server 2019 (Standard or Datacenter).
- Windows Server 2016 (Standard or Datacenter).
- Windows Server 2012 R2 (Standard or Datacenter).

3. Active Directory Requirements:

- Domain Controllers: All domain controllers in the forest must run one of the supported versions of Windows Server.
- Active Directory Forest Functional Level: Windows Server 2012 R2 or higher.
- Active Directory Site: The site where you install Exchange Server must contain at least one writable domain controller that is also a global catalog server; otherwise, the installation will fail.
